

AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES WINTER 2016

It's time to start thinking about after-school activities again. This time you can get a leg up and register *before* Holiday Break! We will continue to offer signups through Eventbrite.com, unless otherwise noted. These activities will fill up quickly, so be sure to register as soon as you can!*

- **Choir with Kim Aberle for 2nd-5th grade (\$175)**
3:30 to 4:30 p.m. Mondays from January 25 - May 9
- **Chess Club with Chess Performance for all grades (\$125)**
3:30 to 4:30 p.m. Tuesdays from January 12 - May 17
- **Glass Art with alum Naomi Stuecker for 1st Grade and up (\$130)**
3:30 to 5:00 p.m. Mondays from January 11 - February 29
A beginners' class in fusing and slumping, and kiln-formed glass. Students make small fused pieces and learn about safety and all the properties of designing and building kiln-formed glass art. This is a six-week course.
- **Glass Art II with alum Naomi Stuecker for 1st Grade and up (\$130)**
3:30 to 5:00 p.m. Wednesdays from January 13 - February 24
In this six-week course, students who took the fall class can continue learning how to cut glass and fire it in new ways. Students will sculpt a small solid glass piece, along with designing practical items like dishes, barrettes and coasters. The Glass II group will create a group hanging piece for the school: a glass patchwork quilt.
- **Anime Club with Andrew Frechette for 5th Grade and up (\$75)**
3:30 to 4:30 Mondays from January 11 - February 29
The Anime Club's focus will be screening age-appropriate anime, practicing and improving our drawing, and discussing major recurring themes in various anime shows and movies. Members should bring a love for anime, sharing their work and trying out new things.
- **Chinese Painting with Qianxin Zhu for 3rd Grade and up (\$75)**
3:30 to 4:30 Thursdays from January 14 - February 25
In this six-week course, Chinese teacher Qianxin Zhu will teach students the basics of Chinese art. The group will learn to draw a variety of flora and fauna, in addition to learning calligraphy.
- **Table Tennis with Qianxin Zhu for 3rd Grade and up (\$75)**
3:30 to 4:30 Tuesdays from January 12 - February 23
In this six-week course, Qianxin Zhu will work with students to teach them the basics of ping-pong.
- **Legos for Kindergarten - 2nd Grade (\$75)**
3:30 to 4:30 Tuesdays from January 12 - February 23
BRICKS 4 KIDZ programs provide an extraordinary atmosphere for students to build unique creations and explore architecture and engineering, including famous buildings, motorized

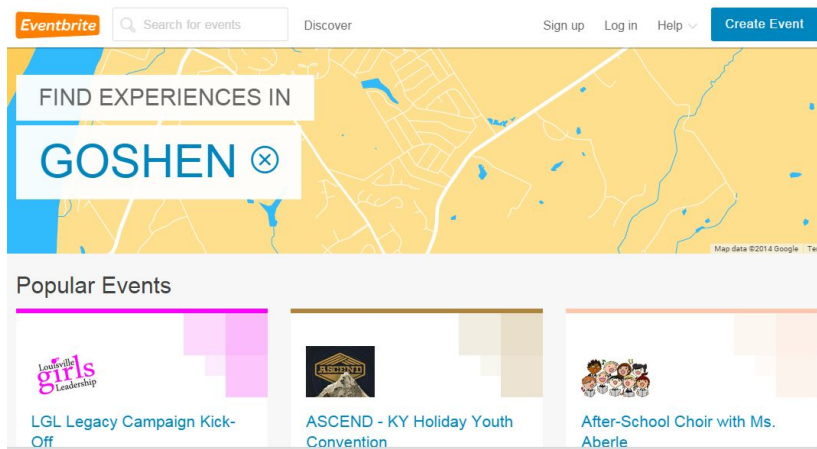
machines and inventions, all while having fun using LEGO® bricks.
