



## 9TH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

At the August Book Sale, you will purchase all needed books (used books through the Parent Association and new books from Gray's Bookstore, which will be on-site) and a planner (more on that below). You will also select your locker at that time.

Each teacher will have his or her own method of asking you to take notes, complete assignments, etc., and will give you details during the first week of class. However, generally speaking, you will need the following items:

- A means of note-taking and keeping assignments organized for each class. You may prefer a notebook and folder for each class, or binders with pocket folders and paper; the choice is yours.
- A TI-84 Plus graphing calculator (any version: Silver, C Silver, or CE)
- Looseleaf paper
- Pens, pencils, highlighters
- Backpack or bag (you may take these to class with you if you wish)
- All 9th graders also must use a planner. (Planners are recommended, but not mandatory, for other grade levels.) You should have it with you at school and in every class, at all times. There are several options:
  - We have created a customized St. Francis planner, with important school dates included, that is available at the Book Sale for \$10.
  - If you prefer to use a planner that you have found on your own, that is also fine. It must have significant spaces for each day (it cannot be simply a monthly or weekly calendar).
  - If you have a technological device you plan on bringing to school (computer, iPad, etc.) that has a calendar feature you want to use, that too is acceptable. However, please do note above – it must be an item you plan to bring to each class, as you will need to add things to the calendar multiple times per day.

As a reminder, all students should arrive to the first day of school with their summer reading and writing assignment complete. We will send an email out about the assignment by June and it will also be posted on the school website.
